



## Emergency Sewer Repair Project NOS Unit 28 Phase II CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

### Project Information

This is an EMERGENCY SEWER REPAIR PROJECT. The sewer system is urgently in need of repair due to aging and deterioration. To ensure public safety, it is imperative that we perform this critical infrastructure improvement work.

### Construction Activities

Cleaning of the pipe on Acama Street between Fair Avenue and Vineland Avenue

- Mobilization of equipment & construction site set-up
- Staging of construction equipment/material at the work site noted above
- Cleaning of the sewer pipe utilizing the two access pits at Acama & Fair and Acama & Vineland
- Regular removal of pipe debris from work site via large trucks

### Work Schedule and Location

**Time:** 7:00am-4:00pm, Monday-Friday

**When:** Work will begin on Monday, April 13, 2020. This work will take approximately 1-2 weeks, depending on the amount of debris found inside the pipe

**Where:** Acama Street between Fair Avenue & Vineland Avenue

### What you need to know

- Due to the nature of the cleaning work, you may experience odors. These are normal and should lessen once this work is complete. We are taking measures to mitigate these odors, including:
  - Activation of Odor Scrubber Unit. This unit intakes air, “scrubs” it of particles utilizing carbon and other materials, and then releases clean air back into the atmosphere
  - Spraying down the access pits with a safe, nontoxic deodorizer
  - Daily monitoring of gas levels at the access pits
  - Expediting haul-away of any debris removed from the pipe
- “No Parking” areas within the construction work zone with advanced notification
- Road closures at Acama Street & Fair Avenue and Acama Street & Vineland Avenue
- You may notice some dust, noise, and vibration
- Driveway, trash, sidewalk, and delivery access will be maintained at all times
- Schedule is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances

### Contact Us
