REQUEST TO USE INTERLAYER ASPHALTIC CEMENT CONCRETE AS A FINAL COVER FOR HAUL ROAD AT LOPEZ CANYON LANDFILL, LAKE VIEW TERRACE (FILE No. 69-068)

Dear Mr. Fortune:

We have received your letter dated September 11, 2006, to this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) requesting our approval to use Interlayer Asphaltic Cement Concrete as the final cover and asphalt grindings as a foundation layer for the haul road at the Lopez Canyon Sanitary Landfill. On October 4, 2006, Mr. Kelly Gharios of your staff submitted a map that displays the construction plan of the haul road to the Regional Board via e-mail. The submitted information indicates that the proposed final cover system for the haul road would include (from top to bottom): two 3-inch Asphaltic Cement Concrete layers separated by a non-woven geotextile that is impregnated by a 40-mil tack coat, at least four feet of asphalt street grindings, and at least four feet of clean soil over refuse.

We have reviewed the information provided and have determined that your proposal is consistent with the Waste Discharge Requirements included in Order No. R4-2004-017 that was adopted for the Lopez Canyon Landfill by this Regional Board on November 2, 2004. Your request is therefore approved.
