Exempt Employment is based on a short term, As-Needed basis. No Benefits (No Medical/dental/retirement benefits). These are exempt, at-will positions. Exempt employees serve at the will of the appointing authority, and as such, they may be discharged without cause. Candidates selected for these part-time positions will be required to work on an as-needed basis, no more than 1,000 hours per service year. These hours could be worked or assigned consecutively or intermittently Monday thru Sunday and there is no minimum guaranteed number of hours per week or per year

POSITION(S) AVAILABLE: The Department of Public Works – LA Sanitation is looking to fill various part time Maintenance Laborer positions located throughout the City of Los Angeles.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 18 years of age.

Valid California License required (Applicants will be disqualified and not eligible for hire if within the past 36 months they were convicted of a major moving violation, such as driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs, and may be disqualified if there are three or more moving violations and/or at-fault accidents within the past 36 months).

<u>JOB DESCRIPTION</u>: Depending on the position being filled, may be assigned as a member of a maintenance crew engaged in work such as cleaning alley ways, sidewalks, and homeless encampments, including sweeping and removal of litter from premises; assist Refuse Collection Truck Operator in the loading and unloading of residential refuse, bulky items, and Dead Animal Collection (DAC) Assist Wastewater Collection Workers in responding to and mitigating spills by helping with such tasks as setting up traffic control, setting up equipment, cleaning pipes, setting up hoses; may be assigned other manual labor assignments based on work location.
