Background

This project will be to rehabilitate Unit 1 by UV Cure in place pipe method. The Unit 1 alignment originates from the intersection of Western Avenue and 52nd Street, then proceeds west on 62nd Street. It will then turn north on Van Ness Avenue until it reaches the south branch of the NOS and COS on Slauson Avenue.

Summary

- There will be temporary parking restrictions during work hours. Signs will be posted in advance in designated construction zones
- You may see trucks, construction workers, equipment, and supplies such as pipes in the work area. There will be open trenches during work hours and debris removal. Contractor will steel plate after working hours.
- You may detect odors from time to time. This is normal, and the odors will cease once the work is complete.
- You will be notified 24-48 hours in advance of any temporary interruption in sewer services.
