CA STATE RECYCLING MANDATES

CA STATE ASSEMBLY BILL 1826

MANDATORY COMMERCIAL ORGANICS RECYCLING

**Businesses and Multi-family Residential Dwellings
MUST HAVE an organics recycling program in place by:**

January 1, 2019

Generators of
4 or more cubic yards
of solid waste, including
trash, recycling, and
organics **per week**.

December 31, 2020

Generators of
2 or more cubic yards
of solid waste **per week**,
including trash, recycling,
and organics.

Note: Multi-family residential dwellings are **NOT**
required to recycle food waste at this time.

How to Comply

- Subscribe to Green Container organic waste services from your recyclA Service Provider.
- Recycle all of your organic waste onsite or through a Landscaping Contractor.

Organics

Defined by the State as food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, nonhazardous wood waste, and food-soiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste.

CA STATE ASSEMBLY BILL 341

MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING

You are required to have recycling service if you are either:

**A business that
regularly disposes
of solid waste.**

OR

**A multi-family
dwelling of
5 units or more.**

How to Comply

- Subscribe to Blue Container Recycling service from your recyclA Service Provider.
- Separate your recyclable materials from your trash and take them to a recycling center.
