

CA STATE ASSEMBLY BILL 1826

MANDATORY COMMERCIAL ORGANICS RECYCLING

Businesses and Multi-family Residential Dwellings MUST HAVE an organics recycling program in place by:

January 1, 2019

Generators of

4 or more cubic yards
of solid waste, including
trash, recycling, and
organics per week.

December 31, 2020

Generators of

2 or more cubic yards
of solid waste per week,
including trash, recycling,
and organics.

Note: Multi-family residential dwellings are **NOT** required to recycle food waste at this time.

CA STATE ASSEMBLY BILL 341

MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING

You are required to have recycling service if you are either:

A business that regularly disposes of solid waste.

OR

A multi-family dwelling of 5 units or more.

How to Comply

- Subscribe to Green Container organic waste services from your recycLA Service Provider.
- Recycle all of your organic waste onsite or through a Landscaping Contractor.

Organics

Defined by the State as food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, nonhazardous wood waste, and foodsoiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste.

How to Comply

- Subscribe to Blue Container Recycling service from your recycLA Service Provider.
- Separate your recyclable materials from your trash and take them to a recycling center.
