THE BROWNFIELDS PROGRAM

The Brownfields Program is a nationally recognized program to assist in removing barriers to redevelopment posed by brownfields throughout the City of Los Angeles, particularly in disadvantaged communities. These properties are usually vacant and often blighted, so their redevelopment contributes to urban and community renewal by transforming them into vibrant new commercial, residential, or recreational opportunities in the neighborhood.

The Green Business Program recognizes businesses that meet environmental standards established by the California Green Business Network (CAGBN).
